Resolution to Support the Referendum of HB 2305

WHEREAS, the Arizona Democratic Party strongly opposed the legislature's passage of HB2305, the so- called election reform bill;

WHEREAS, the Arizona Democratic Party believes that the expansion of early voting has been beneficial to making voting more accessible in Arizona;

WHEREAS, the Arizona Democratic Party believes that HB2305 is not only detrimental to the goal of making voting easier and more accessible, but it will disenfranchise voters through unnecessary changes to Arizona's early voting laws;

WHEREAS, the Arizona Democratic Party believes that the voters, given the choice, will vote against HB2305;

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Arizona Democratic Party strongly supports the referendum of HB2305 and encourages all Democratic precinct committeepersons and activists to support this effort by gathering signatures and canvassing voters in their precinct.
